


# Herbicide Use May Restrict Options for Cover Crops

- 1. Herbicide residues may prevent successful establishment of the cover crop(s)
- 2. Some herbicide residues could be detected in meat and milk products
- Follow label restrictions: The label is the law!
- Examples of herbicides with short grazing restrictions: Basagran and Harmony (do not graze or cut fields treated for at least 30 days after last treatment)
- Look for less restrictive herbicides or alternative cover crop species

## **ROTATIONAL CROP RESTRICTIONS**

The following rotational crops may be planted after applying Flexstar GT 3.5 at specified rates:

Rotational Crops	Planting Time From Last Flexstar GT 3.5 Application
Bean, Dry Bean, Snap Cotton Potato Soybean Soybean, Succulent (edamame)	0 months

Sorghum <sup>3</sup>	18 months
All other crops not listed above	18 months

- <sup>1</sup> 4 months in Region 1
- <sup>2</sup> 8 months in Region 1
- <sup>3</sup> 10 months in Region 1
- <sup>4</sup> 12 months in the states of Ohio, Kentucky, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, and Region 4 and 4a when applied at rates of 3.5 pints per acre or more
- 5 18 months in the states of Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont and Region 5

Do not graze rotated small grain crops or harvest forage or straw for livestock.
