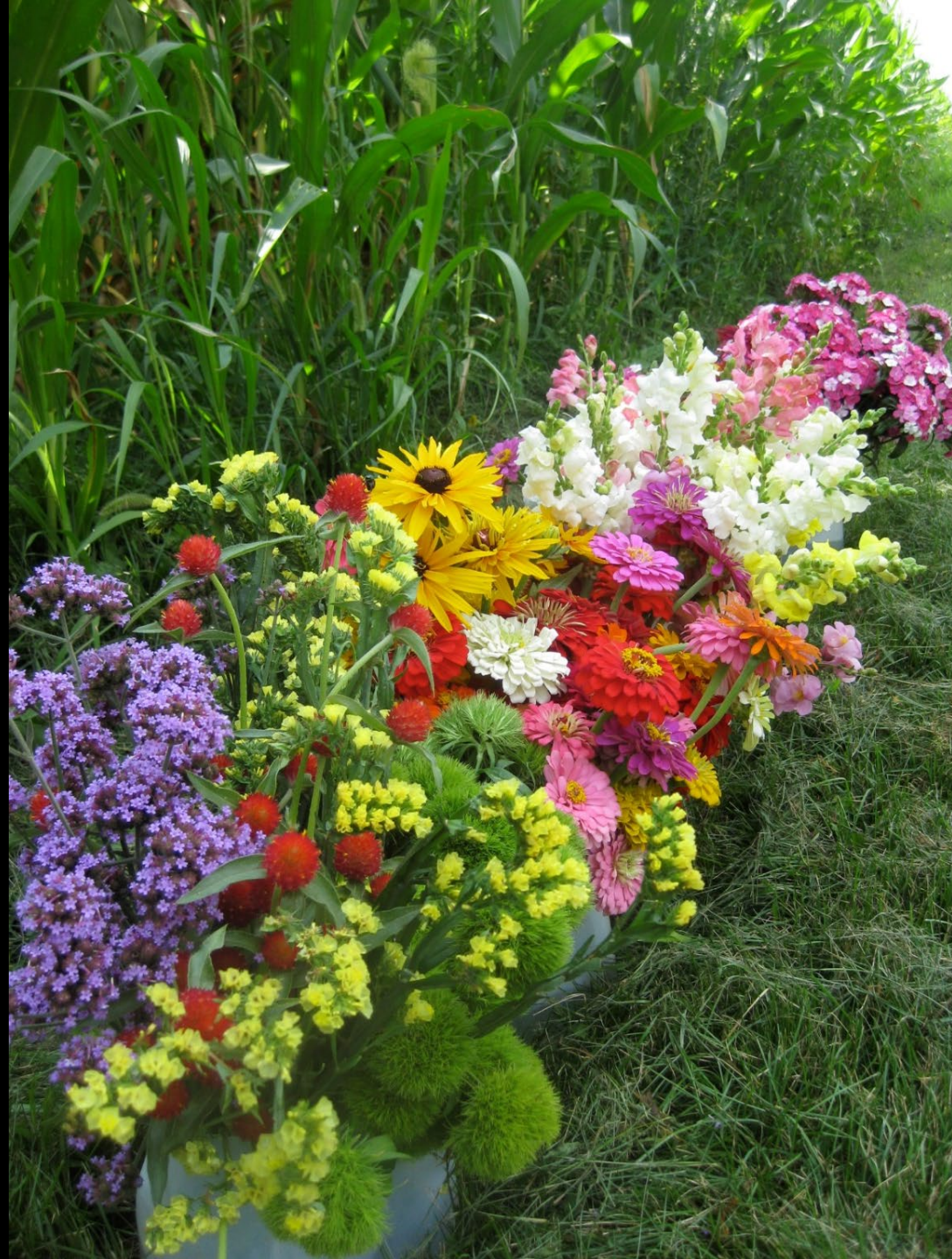


















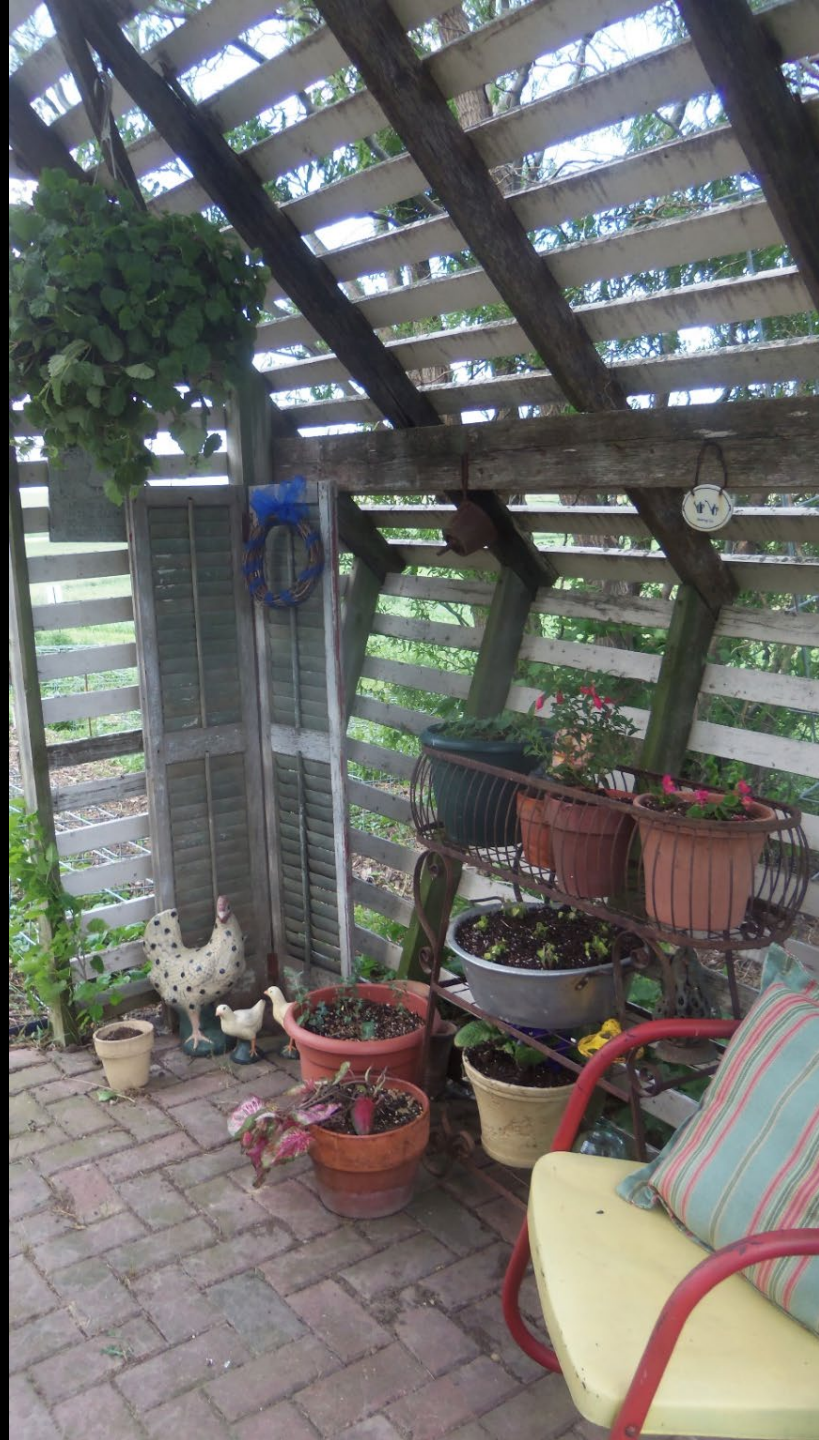

DANVERS 126 HALF LONG #CR102 Great for heavy soil. 70 days. The original Danvers Half Long dates back to the 1870s. This strain, "126", was improved in the 1940s. The old standard American carrot, adaptable and dependable. Thick 7" roots have good flavor. Productive. Pkt \$2.50 or 1 oz \$3.75



DARA FLOWERING CARROT #FL134 Amazing blooms! Queen Anne's Lace is the familiar wild form of carrot, and the white-flowered version has been appreciated for years as a delicate filler in beds and flower arrangements. But 'Dara' is a spectacular, vividly white, but change to soft pink and finally to a deep, rich rose-red. The lacy flower heads reach to 4 ft tall. Large amount of flowers over a long season. Pkt (20 seeds) \$3.00



AMARILLO #CR114 Sweet, lemon yellow roots. 60 days. Lovely, lemon-yellow roots have sweet, bright yellow flesh. The large 8" roots and strong flavor are good for a summer carrot.



LITTLE FINGER #CR103 Slender "fingers" are extra tender. 55 days. Sweet 3" baby-type carrots are great for snacks. These superb, bright orange carrots were developed in France for canning and pickling. Pkt \$2.50



PUSA ASITA, BLACK CARROT #CR130 Warm weather favorite. Packed with anti-oxidants. This is the...



NANTES SCARLET #CR122 Half-long type. 65-74 days. Sweet, brilliant orange, cylindrical roots are delicate and fine-grained, containing almost no core. This half-long variety reaches only 6"-7" in length and about 1 1/2" in diameter, so it is a good type to try on heavier soils. High moisture content make this a natural for juicing or it is fine for storing. Originally from France, but grown in this country for many decades. Pkt \$2.50



WHITE WONDER (BLANCHE D'AMSTERDAM) Amazing roasted! A big, lanky carrot that was common in many of Europe's soups. The long roots are white with green shoulders, and can be used in the kitchen or as an animal feed (as used in the 1820s). Volmsen said in 1985, "This is a 16th century excellence. There is hardly any farm on which it is not grown to some extent for feeding cattle, and especially horses." They also said it was developed from the White Carrot, which was also a great...
