

The bee population is declining in Iowa due to many factors: mites, pesticides, loss of habitat and more. **Creating more spaces where bees and other beneficial insects can thrive** is one way farmers can help.

"Places where you are not able to physically farm or would not be profitable to farm are great places to help pollinators of all kinds," says **Ai Wen,** assistant professor of biology at University of Northern Iowa.
