## Helpful connections between farmers, land and markets

Last Monday, **Tika Bhandari** showed PFI viability program staff around her quarter-acre plot in West Des Moines, Iowa. Tika and her family moved to Iowa from Bhutan in 2008.

In addition to familiar market garden crops like cabbage and cherry tomatoes, Tika grows African and Asian crops like bitter melon, bottle gourd, white eggplant, water spinach, sweet potato greens and long beans. Tika is one of the 13 farmers participating in the **<u>Global Greens Farm</u> <u>incubator program</u>**, which connects farmers who came to Iowa as refugees with land. She sells through farmers markets and through Global Greens' collaborative CSA.

Tika and Global Greens are also participating in the **Iowa Local Food Purchasing Assistance Program (ILFPA)**, which supports partnerships with local producers and underserved communities.


