Meet Monika, a Farmland Access Navigator

Monika Owczarski has been farming in Des Moines since 2016, when she founded <u>Sweet Tooth Farm.</u> She's gained and lost many farm plots over the years and is passionate about helping farmers find land that is viable, equitable and sustainable.

Monika is a farmland access coordinator, which is part of PFI's tri-state collaboration with <u>Renewing the Countryside</u> and <u>Marbleseed.</u>

In this role, she helps beginning farmers better prepare to search for and acquire farmland tenure.

We asked Monika: *What is the most meaningful part of being a Land Access Navigator?*

"Offering another perspective, reframing and restructuring what land access can look like for landowners and land seekers," she says. "It's equally as satisfying to show landowners ways they can offer land in an equitable way as it is to find the right land for a farmer."

Monika's expertise is "land in urban areas." She can help to build fair, clear and documented leases, work on contract negotiations, navigate zoning laws, cultivate relationships with the community surrounding your land and more.
