New cover crop app available

Practical Farmers has released a new cover crop app designed to help farmers locate cover crop seed suppliers and service providers in time for fall 2021 planting decisions. The free app, Find Cover Crops, is available for download on the Apple App Store, Google Play Store and a desktop version is also available. The Find Cover Crops app lets users:

- Search by location or GPS for at least 44 cover crop seed dealers, seed cleaning and custom spraying services located across lowa and surrounding states
- Request aerial application, custom drilling and high-clearance seeding services from their phones or computer
- Access management recommendations, including embedded how-to videos for seeding, grazing and terminating cover crops
- Precisely identify the boundaries of fields to be cover cropped using the app's "Find My Field" feature, which lets users search for, mark and send images of a field to businesses



This app design is based on what farmers have voiced as their biggest questions and challenges related to cover crops. It will serve as a tool that can empower farmers by helping to simplify cover crop planning and management.

Iowans: Apply for Water Quality Initiative cost share today!

First-time cover croppers are eligible for \$25 per acre, while farmers who have experience using cover crops and are continuing the practice can receive \$15 per acre. Reduced tillage and nitrapyrin nitrification inhibitor cost share is also available.

Cost share funding through IDALS is capped at 160 acres per farmer or landowner. Contact your local Soil and Water Conservation District office to submit an application!
