Research report: "Overwintering Greens: Species and Seeding Dates"



Iowa farmers often overwinter spinach, but what other greens can survive the winter? Humble Hands Harvest did research to learn more. Though the plants weren't harvestable in April, their trial will inform how they plant in the future.

Practical Cover Croppers: "Seeding Cover Crops With an Air Seeder and Rolling Harrow"



Will Cannon of Prairie City, Iowa, has improvised a method for seeding cover crops quickly and inexpensively. The setup: a Hiniker air seeder with Gandy seed meters mounted on a frame he made that pulls a preowned J&M double-rolling harrow.

Will explains how the system places the seed close to the soil under corn residue while breaking down corn residue without causing soil disturbance. <u>Watch the video for a</u> <u>close-up view of the system</u>.
