
## Register TODAY for On Common Ground: PFI's annual conference

# **Butchery Innovation and Revitalization Fund grant application open**

Small-scale meat processors seeking support can now apply for grant funding. The first step in the application process – a pre-application assessment – is due Nov. 28.

The grants are for processors to expand, refurbish or establish a small-scale meat processing facility, licensed custom locker or mobile slaughter unit.

Grants can also be used to rent or purchase cold storage or equipment needed to expand capacity.
