Meet Hannah Breckbill, a Farmland Access Navigator

In 2017, **Hannah Breckbill** (left) started a worker-owned cooperative farm, Humble Hands Harvest, in Decorah, Iowa, which she co-owns with **Emily Fagan** (right). She works with beginning farmers on land access with a lot of interest in group and community ownership models. Hannah was recognized in 2021 as a Changemaker by <u>Marbleseed.</u>

Hannah is a Farmland Access Navigator for Renewing the Countryside.

In her role, she helps beginning farmers better prepare to search for and acquire farmland tenure.

We asked Hannah: What is one benefit and one challenge to farming in group or community ownership models?

Hannah: "The main benefit is that you get to pool your resources and, with more people, there is more resilience to financial and physical challenges. A challenge is making sure that everyone is on the same page, understanding each other's feelings and needs, and having the same set of visions and values."
