Research report: Camelina ahead of corn and soybeans



Small grains species like cereal rye and winter wheat are popular winter cover crops in corn-soybean systems due to their ability to overwinter, but what other options might exist?

A group of three PFI cooperators trialed winter camelina, a brassica species that can overwinter in certain conditions, in 2020.

Five seasons, 5 iterations of cover crop variety trials



Still deciding which cover crop to plant this fall? Our cooperators' program has several years of cover crop variety trial data at the ready!

In a 2017 trial, seven cooperators compared establishment in corn and soybeans for different species including winter wheat, hairy vetch, rapeseed and more.


