Meet Claire Wilson, a beginning farmer at West Fork Farmstead

Claire Wilson farms at <u>West Fork Farmstead</u> with her sister, **Natasha**, and her parents, **Brian and Nancy**. Claire is a social worker with an aptitude for mechanical jobs and a passion for all things animals and outdoors. She returned to the farm in 2023 and is learning to care for the animals, assisting Brian with creative farm projects and scheming up ways she could live by the farm pond.

We asked Claire: How has your perspective of your family farm changed over the years?

Claire: "If you'd asked me as I was growing up if I'd ever have considered coming back to our family farm, I would've told you 'absolutely no way.' I greatly disliked the conventional side of farming – it felt tedious, stinky and disconnected from the animals we raised.

When my parents and sister decided to transition the farm from wholly conventional to include more diverse and regenerative practices, my perspective began to change. The way we farm now allows for more connection with our animals.

I hope anyone who feels the way I used to about farming has opportunities to be exposed to the more symbiotic practices of regenerative agriculture."
