Whether you planted cover crops last year or are considering it for the future, we're here to support you with financial assistance and agronomic support through PFI's cover crop cost-share.

In 2023, nearly twice as many farmers enrolled in our cover crop cost-share than in the 2022 season. Over **1,900 enrollees** throughout the Midwest seeded over 600,000 acres of cover crops.

In addition, **970 participants became PFI members** for the first time. They say access to a community of seasoned cover croppers helped them get started with confidence. "I learned a lot from hearing about other farmer's experiences," notes **Cheri Klyn** of New Sharon, Iowa.

New program: Save on nitrogen costs; safeguard your bottom line



Ever wonder if your nitrogen rate to corn is unnecessarily cutting into your bottom line?

In the <u>N Rate Risk Protection</u> <u>Program</u>, participants reduce their N rate by at least 20 pounds of nitrogen per acre.

If they experience a yield loss below 95% of their non-adjusted APH, the program pays \$35 per acre to help make up the difference. <u>Enroll by April</u> <u>30.</u>
