# Researching pastured goats and sheep with PFI's Cooperators' Program

Last year, goat farmers **Adam Ledvina** of Chelsea, Iowa, and **Bailey Lutz** of Decorah, Iowa, alongside sheep farmers **Hannah Breckbill** and **Emily Fagan** of Decorah, Iowa, completed the trial "Castration Timing in Goats and Sheep."

As they enter kidding season, Adam and Bailey are gearing up for their next trial, exploring what effect weaning timing has on the growth rates of market animals.

"There's very little contemporary information available around the economics of goat rearing, especially fully pastured herds," Bailey says.

Adam adds, "Projects like this can help other producers learn from cooperators who raise animals like they do in a real-world setting."


