

## New research report: "Interseeding Cover Crops in Corn"



Interseeding cover crops into standing corn is a growing practice that allows for earlier cover crop establishment and grazing opportunities.

Cooperator **Noah Wendt** investigated the corn yield and fall forage potential effects of interseeding a diverse, coolseason cover crop mix versus a warmseason sorghum-millet mix in his organic corn field.

New research report: "Holganix Bio 800+ Compost Tea for Corn"



Jack Boyer of Reinbeck, IA, investigated the yield impact of applying Holganix Bio 800+, a commercial compost tea, at corn planting in addition to his regular corn fertilizer treatment.

Jack found that Holganix Bio 800+ did not affect corn yield and cost an extra \$20/ac to apply compared to his standard nutrient program.
