A look at history, inspiring paths toward a resilient future

Last Tuesday, PFI staff gathered at McFarland Park in Ames, Iowa, to spend a day delving into the history of agriculture in Iowa.

The deep dive started with an overview of the First Peoples of what would become Iowa. Staff then learned how the landscape, agriculture and communities were shaped by European settlement, the Green Revolution and the farm crisis of the 1980s that led to the founding of Practical Farmers.

We were fortunate to hear from experts Albert Lacson of Grinnell College, Andy Olson of the Tallgrass Prairie Center, retired agronomist Matt Liebman, Margaret Smith of Albert Lea Seed and Ash Grove Farm, Denise O'Brien of Rolling Acres Farm and **Larry Kallem** (pictured above), one of PFI's cofounders.

The session was the first of a three-part series where staff are exploring the contexts that led to today's agricultural realities, so we can work toward a more resilient future.
