## Comparing cover crops for maximum fall forage



In his 2023 research trial, **Noah Wendt** of Huxley, Iowa, trialed interseeding different cover crops into standing corn, aiming to maximize fall growth for earlier grazing.

Noah compared cool-season and warm-season cover crops to learn which would generate the most biomass without impacting corn yield.
