Research report: "Castration Timing in Goats and Sheep"



Last year, goat farmers **Adam**Ledvina and Bailey Lutz, alongside sheep farmers **Hannah Breckbill** and Emily Fagan, completed a castration timing trial. Read the report.

Adam and Bailey are getting ready for their next trial to explore what effect weaning timing has on growth rates.

"Projects like this can help other producers learn from cooperators who raise animals like they do in a realworld setting," Adam says.

HPAI detected in cattle



Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza A has mostly been a concern for poultry flocks but, at the start of April, HPAI was detected in dairy cattle in several states.

So far, evidence suggests the disease is passed from migrating birds and not between cows. No cattle deaths have been reported.

The <u>USDA issued recommendations</u> for farmers to help prevent further disease spread, and the University of Wisconsin Extension has assembled **this fact sheet.**

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture is accepting applications for two grant opportunities.

The AGRI Livestock Investment Grant can be used for equipment purchases and physical improvements on livestock farms.
