Evolving information about HPAI in cattle

Since highly pathogenic avian influenza A was detected in dairy cattle earlier this year, guidance on health and safety for herds and milk supplies have continued to evolve. The Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship recommends that Iowa dairy farmers enhance their biosecurity protocols and practices,

communicate regularly with their herd veterinarian and report any unusual symptoms in cattle to IDALS at 515-281-5305.




Winter webinar recording: "Establishing and grazing native perennials"
