Overwintering spinach is the practice of insulating a fall-planted spinach crop through the winter to produce an early spring crop of spinach.

Farmer-researchers Hannah Breckbill, Emily Fagan, Natasha Hegmann, Peter Kerns and Mark

Quee investigated the best time to plant spinach for overwintering and tested whether direct-seeding versus transplanting performed better.
