The Wallaces raise farrow-to-finish hogs, cattle, chicken, sheep and crops, including small grains. At their recent PFI field day, they showcased their integrated system that includes small grains to feed livestock and capturing manure to fertilize crop fields.

The Wallaces are also developing their pasture-based pig farrowing system using huts, pictured above. Their hope is to have a constant flow of piglets born throughout the year.

New research: Tarping for weed control in horticulture production



Tarping is an increasingly common practice on vegetable farms for bed preparation and weed or cover crop termination, especially in no-till or minimal-till systems.

Horticulture farmers Hannah Breckbill and Emily Fagan, along with Marlon Mormann, did an on-farm research project to answer questions relevant to their operations, including what duration of tarping is most effective for killing rye and if clear tarps can effectively get rid of perennial weeds.
