

Farmer curiosity drives research trials: Sean Dengler explores nitrogen rate reduction on his farm

Field crop farmer **Sean Dengler** of Dysart, Iowa, wondered if he could reduce nitrogen on his farm without sacrificing yield. Sean decided to put his curiosity to the test as one of 19 participants in the 2024 PFI research trial investigating the impact of reducing applied nitrogen.

In <u>this video</u>, Sean shares the nitrogen rates he tested in 2023 and 2024, discusses his experience as a PFI cooperator and encourages other farmers to conduct on-farm research to improve their farms.
